The people of Pakistan continue to support the people of Kashmir in their fight towards their goal by observing Kashmir Solidarity Day on 5th February every year. University of Chakwal organized a walk for Solidarity on Kashmir.





#### DENOUNCING OF REVOCATION OF ARTICEL 370 AND 35 (A)

An awareness Seminar was held at UoC followed by a solidarity walk to expose the sinister design of India behind unilaterally revoking Article 370 of the Indian Constitution together with scraping Article 35 A, which gave special privileges to the people of Kashmir. Article 307 allowed the State of Kasmir a certain amount of autonomy, like its own constitution, a separate flag, parliament, freedom to make laws, permanent residency, ownership of property, and fundamental rights.

PM Modi and the Hindu Nationalist BJP had long opposed Article 370 and revoking it was in the party's 2019 election manifesto. After returning to power in the April-May general elections, the government lost no time in acting on its sinister pledge.

Critics of Modi link this move to the economic slowdown India was facing. The buck does not stop there. The Kashmiris believe that the BJP ultimately wants to change the demographic character of the Muslimmajority region by allowing non-Kasmiris to buy land there. The move also fits in with Modi's desire to show that the BJP is tough on Kashmir, and Pakistan.

Moreover, the government is also moving to break up the State into two smaller, federally administrative territories. One region will combine Muslim-majority Kasmir and Hindu-majority Jammu. The other is Buddhist-majority Ladakh, which is culturally and historically close to Tibet.

P. Chidambaram, a senior leader in the opposition Congress party described the BJP decision as a "catastrophic step" and warned in Indian Parliament that it could have serious consequences. He further said that you may think that you have scored a victory, but you are wrong and history will prove you to be wrong.

#### Why revoking Article 370 is illegal?

It is provided within Article 307 that any changes in this Article will require the approval of the State of Kashmir. Furthermore, revoking Article 370 is a clear violation of the UN Resolutions, which entitle the people of Kasmir to the right to self-determination.

The audience has explained the location of Kashmir vis a vis Gilgit Baltistan, Chinese-administered areas across the border, and the wide stretch of the border along Azad Kasmir. It was emphasized to the faculty to raise voices against the revoking of Articles 370 and 35A by India and its repercussions via print, tele and electronic media.
