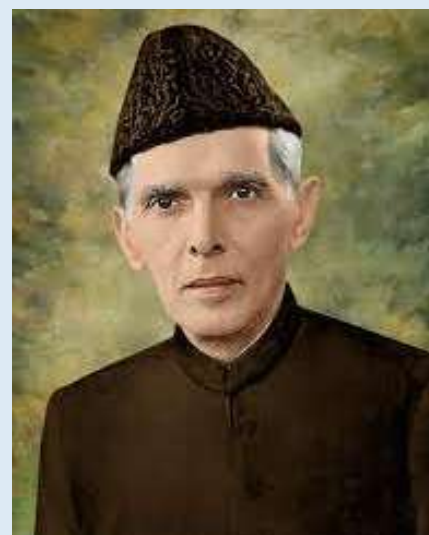

REGISTRAR'S MESSAGE

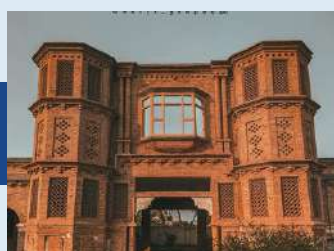

ESTABLISHMENT OF UOC

An exalted chapter was added in the history of Pakistan as well as the Chakwal district on 17th January 2020, by merging the sub-campus of UET, Taxila, and the postgraduate college in the establishment of the UOC. It was a wonderful occasion that the college established in 1949, was upgraded to the level of a University with the dedicated efforts of the third generation of the founder family of the same college. Today it is the hub of knowledge that offers a unique blend of modern sciences, engineering, humanities, social sciences, business administration, pharmacy, and Law among others, offering high-quality education at affordable rates. Spanning over 155 acres, and offering 20 Programs, UOC is the largest general public sector university in the Rawalpindi Division. Its twin campuses, the City Campus and the Balkasar Campus provide a serene atmosphere for learning and progress. The Balkasar Campus is uniquely situated and distinctly visible from the M2 Motorway.



TRIBUTES TO RAJA YASSIR HUMAYUN SARFRAZ



**RAJA YASSIR HUMAYUN
SARFRAZ KHAN**

Raja Yassir Humayun Sarfraz Khan is the former Provisional Minister of Higher Education and IT. His contributions to the cause of Higher Education in Punjab are monumental. He aptly administered over 30 Universities in the Province, allowing for the needy capacity-building measures, uplift, and progress of these higher education institutions. He was instrumental in establishing the University of Chakwal (UOC) by merging the UET, Taxila sub-campus, and the Post Graduate College operative since 1949. The University Real Estate comprises the City and the Balkasar Campuses, the latter situated on the M2 Motorway, spanning over 155 acres of prime land, out of which 40 acres were contributed by the former Minister's grandfather, Raja Muhammed Sarfraz Khan, a member of the Pakistan Movement and Punjab Legislative Council

from 1929 to 1937, and a member of the Punjab Legislative Assembly from 1937 to 1958. Raja Muhammad Sarfraz Khan also contributed Pkr one lac during this early period to establish the Post Graduate College, now a part of the UOC. Since its inception in 2020, UOC has seen enormous growth and progress in its infrastructure, academic programs, multi-disciplinary character, and international collaborations. UOC is bristling with a student population of more than five thousand reading in seven Faculties having HEC-compliant faculty. All technical programs have been upgraded with State-of-the-Art equipment with an investment of Pkr 300M. A modest beginning in 2020, UOC is currently the largest general public sector University in Rawalpindi Division. The completion of Pkr 3.0 billion ongoing expansion in infrastructure at the twin campuses in 2024, will enable provision for enrollment of ten thousand students over the next three years in a vibrant university eco-system.

DENOUNCING OF REVOCATION OF ARTICEL 370 AND 35 (A)

An awareness Seminar was held at UOC followed by a solidarity walk to expose the sinister design of India behind unilaterally revoking Article 370 of the Indian Constitution together with scraping Article 35 A, Article 307 allowed the State of Kasmir a certain amount of autonomy, like its own constitution, a separate flag, parliament, freedom to make laws, permanent residency, ownership of property, and fundamental rights.

Critics of Modi link this move to the economic slowdown India was facing.

The buck does not stop there. The Kashmiris believe that the BJP ultimately wants to change the demographic character of the Muslim-majority region by allowing non-Kashmiris to buy land there.

P. Chidambaram, a senior leader in the opposition Congress party described the BJP decision as a "catastrophic step" and warned in Indian Parliament that it could have serious consequences. He further said that you may think that you have scored a victory, but you are wrong and history will prove you to be wrong.

Why revoking Article 370 is illegal?

It is provided within Article 307 that any changes in this Article will require the approval of the State of Kashmir. Furthermore, revoking Article 370 is a clear violation of the UN Resolutions, which entitle the people of Kasmir to the right to self-determination.

**DR. FAREEHA AZMAT**

Dr. Fareeha Azmat is the main architect and organizer for the International Conference on Bridging the gap between Industry and academia. She is a Senior Fellow of the UK Higher Education Academy (HEA) and a Fellow of Warwick International Higher Education Academy (WIHEA). Dr. Freeha is elected a member of the University of Warwick's Senate and has received the 2018 WMG Star Award for Contribution to Undergraduate Education. She has done a master's in computer science from the University of Leicester (UK) on a fully funded scholarship from Higher Education, Pakistan. She was given the Best Student Award and Best Project Award for scoring the highest marks in her master's course. She obtained her Ph.D. in Engineering funded by the University of Warwick Chancellors International Scholarship Award.

After BSc Hons, MSc, and industry-sponsored PhDs in materials science and technology Dr. Kim Stansfield, CEng, MIET, MINCOSE, spent 26 years working in leadership roles in the development of aerospace manufacturing, automotive safety control, enterprise information, and renewable energy systems. In 2016 he joined Warwick University WMG as a senior teaching fellow becoming an associate professor of transformational systems engineering, teaching systems engineering, advanced quality management methods, and business improvement processes for industry-sponsored Apprentice B.Eng. and was course lead on the GE Aviation sponsored M.Sc. Apprenticeship in 'Systems Engineering Technical Leadership'. He recently relaunched as founder-managing Director, VoCATE Ltd. (Voice of the Customer Across the Ecosystem) focused on training and consulting in customer and stakeholder needs-driven product, service, and system innovation

Professor Fernando Colmenares is currently the national head of engineering research and Dr. Professor at the Universidad Cooperativa de Colombia (UCC) with an emphasis on energy generation, simulation, and modeling in the energy sector. 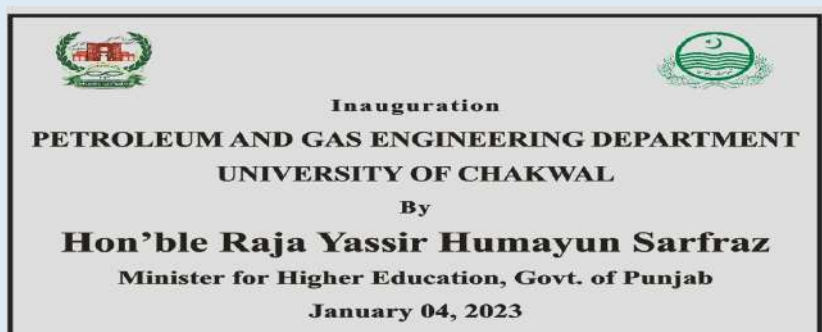

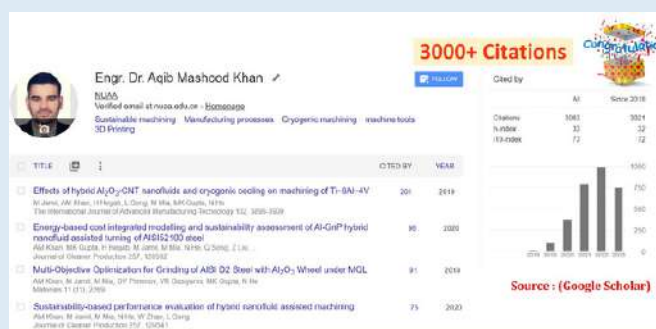
NATIONAL DISASTER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY

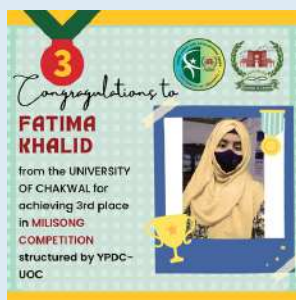


RALLY TO PROTEST DESECRATION OF QURAN

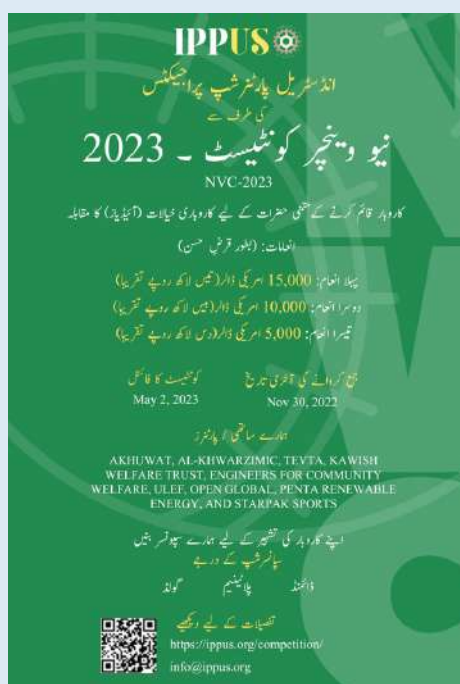

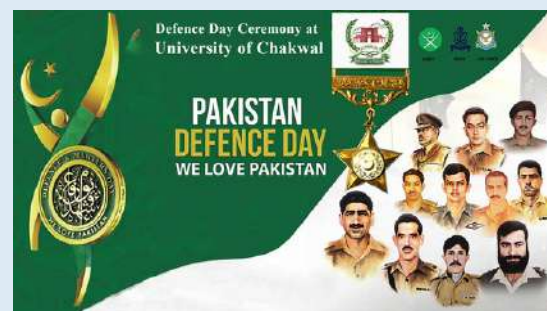
COMMEMORATION OF PAKISTAN'S INDEPENDENCE DAY

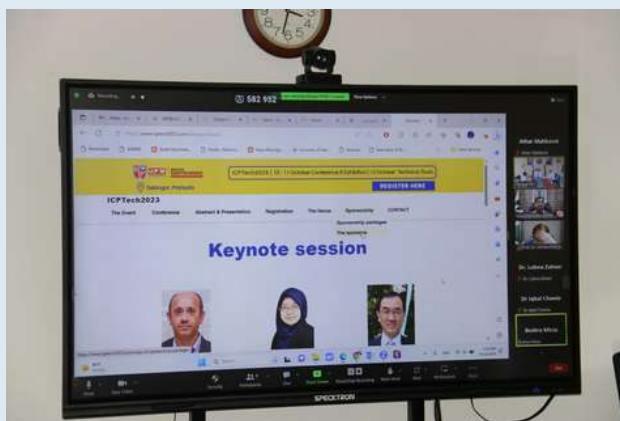
CEREMONY TO PAY TRIBUTE TO THE SHUHADA
